#### 1.ASSEMBLING THE CAMP COT:

- 1. Unzip the bag and remove the camp cot from the bag.
- 2. Carefully place all loose parts on the floor.
- 3. Unpeel the 2 Velcro straps and unwrap the mattress.
- 4.Remove all loose parts and set aside.
- 5. Ensure the center base is up and not pushed down whilst erecting the cot.
- 6. Lift the short sides of the camp cot and make sure the four sides are close to the horizontal .(Fig.B)
- 7. Thereafter push the center base of the camp cot down until it lock into position.
- 8. The cot will now be fully erected, the four sides will be locked into position and the center base will be locked as well.
- 9. Open the plastic bag and take out the mattress . Then place the mattress on the bottom.










#### 2. INSTALLING THE BASSINET:

1. Zip the bassinet on and cover the zipper with the zipper cover to avoid baby from getting injured.







- Thread the tubes into the pockets on the bassinet. There are pockets on either end of the bassinet.
- 3. Connect the tubes together by inserting them into one another.
- 4. There are 2 sets of tubes that need to be parallel to each other.
- 5.Once the bassinet is zipped on, the tubes are inserted and the bassinet is firm. Then place the mattress on top of the poles.






#### 3. CHANGING TABLE INSTRUCTION:


- 1. Connect the 2 short end bars together.
- 2.Attach the diaper changing table by hooking the plastic hooks on the long side rails. Make sure all the hooks are securely engaged with the rails.



#### 4. DAYBED INSTRUCTION:



- 1.Place the daybed inside of the bassinet with the head support at either as shown.
- 2.Insert the tube into the channel on the inside of the bassinet as shown. Pull open channel for insertion.
- 3.Insert metal tube into plastic tube. Make sure the button clicks into place as shown.
- 4.Insert opposite metal tube into plastic tube. Make sure the button clicks into place as shown.



#### 5. ATTACH THE MUSIC BOX AND MOSQUITO NET INSTRUCTION:

 Attach the music box on the top side rail as shown. Attach the mosquito net on the top corner first, and then fix the button of the mosquito net on the handrail as shown.








#### 6. DROP SIDE INSTRUCTION:



- 1. The one long side of the camp cot can be lowered and the camp cot can be placed next to a bed.
- 2.To lower the side rail, unzip the material on the side of the camp cot and press the buttons to lower the rail.
- 3.Roll out the fabric and bind it with the velcro strap.









#### 7.ATTACH TO ADULT BED:

To attach the camp cot to your bed, see pictures below.

#### 8.FOLDING THE CAMP COT:

- 8.1 Remove the following:
- a) Music Box
- b)Mosquito Net
- c) Daybed
- d)Nappy Changer
- e)Bassinet
- f) Mattress
- g) Make sure the side rail is up
- 8.2 Once the above is all removed; pull the strap which is on the center lock upwards, draw together all four corners of the camp cot.
- 8.3 Insert the second level inside the camp cot and place the change mat and accessory holder on the two sides of the camp cot .
- 8.4 Insert the second level and music box inside the camp cot,place the change mat ,daybed and accessories on the sides of the camp cot ,then fasten together by two straps .
- 8.5 Place the camp cot into the travel bag and zip up.

## A PIs noted that ,the mattress should be stored separately out of the travel bag.




