- Never leave the child unattended or without parent/guardian supervision while in this product, as injury could be caused by other parties intentionally or unintentionally. This product can be knocked over and the child can be injured.
- 10. Never lift this product while the child is in it. This can cause this product to fold and thus causing injury to the child seated in this product. When confronted with a staircase, no matter how many steps there are, please use the alternatives such as an elevatoristi or ramp or remove the child from this product before using the staircase.
- Never allow the child to stand on the seat of this product. This can cause this product to fold and thus causing injury to the child. The child can also fall out of this product causing injury to him/herself. This can also cause damage to structure of this product.
- 12. This product is designed for the use of only one child. This product cannot accommodate more than one child.
- 13. Always engage the brake when you are not using this product. Please note, by applying the brake one still cannot leave the child unattended and without parent supervision. If the brake is not engaged properly the product will move.
- Take special care when adjusting the backrest if the child is seated in this product. It is preferred to select the desired backrest position before seating the child this product.
- 15. Prevent and do not allow any child to climb into this product or hang onto the handle bars or any other part of this product. This imbalance of weight can cause this product to topple thus causing injury.
- 16. Do not hang or place any diaper bag or shopping bags or any other item over the handle bars or canopy of this product. This weight can cause damage to this product and also cause this product to fold or topple.
- 17. Storage traysistorage compartments/cup holders are there for convenience and are not suitable for holding large amounts of liquids (hot or cold) or heavy objects. These areas are also not waterproof or leak proof and spillage can occur.



ASSEMBLY>>

Unfold the stroller chassis

- Lift chassis lock lever and open the frame.
- Lift handle until frame locks into upright position as shown.

See picture A&B

Attach the front wheels

- Slide mounting pins, into the housing on the bottom, front wheel housing until they lock into place.
- To remove the front wheels, push the release button, located on the top of the front wheel housing. Then slide the front wheel out.

ATTENTION: make sure the wheels are properly attached by lightly tugging on the wheel.




Attach the rear wheels


- Line up the wheel axle with the rear wheel housing, and slide it in all the way.
 Make sure the wheel is locked in by trying to pull the wheel out slightly.
- To remove the Rear wheels, pull the silver release tab (which is on the inside of the rear wheel housing) down, and slide the wheel out.


PLEASE NOTE: Both the front and rear wheels should be lubricated from time to time, please use an oil based product to maintain your stroller.








How to convert from bassinet to stroller seat mode?

Remove the footcover and liner Undo the buckles underneath. Remove the straps from the small pockets, and secure underneath the base as shown A/B/C

Installing car seat

Align and insert the car seat adaptors to the plastic receivers on the middle of the stroller. Slightly lift up to ensure lock tight.

To remove the car seat, pull the tabs on both sides of the car seat adaptors and lift up the car seat.


Wanring: Make sure to hold the car seat firm and balance while installing or removing the car seat.




Assembly of the seat

Underneath the seat you will find a flap of fabric, with 3 snaps (see diagram), this flap needs to be wrapped around the metal bar, and snapped to the corresponding buttons on the seat fabric (see diagram).

Please make sure to attach the second seat onto the chassis and press the seat unit down to stretch the fabric cover before you button it...






Attach the bumper bar


- Attaching: Slide the pins into the mounts on the seat until they lock into place.
- Removing: push the release button on the bottom of the mounts and pull bumper bar out

NOTE: Front bumper bar must always be used to avoid finger entrapment in the open connectors



Parking brake


 To apply the brake, step on the brake lever, on the inside of the right rear wheel To release the brake, lift the lever up.



Attach the seat


- Refer to diagram D: Pull the seat recline post upwards on both sides.
- Now adjust the posts to a 45 degree angle towards the front of the stroller.
- When attaching the seat, align the connectors on each side of the stroller seat above the
 recline posts. Once aligned, simultaneously
 push the connectors onto the recline posts
 until you hear a "click" from both sides.

NOTE: Seat attaches forward or rear facing.



▲ WARNING: Please make sure that both sides have been attached properly. Try lifting the seat off the chassis: if either side moves, you need to push down until you hear a "click".

 Detaching the Seat: On each side of the seat, you will see on the fabric a marked circle, underneath is a lever. Lift both release levers on the seat locking latch at the same time, Lift upward.



IMPORTANT: Always remove child before detaching the seat




USING YOUR STROLLER>>

Folding the stroller

- Always remove the secondary seat (if in use).
- Always have the primary seat in the forward facing position.
- Always apply brake and remove children before folding the stroller.
- Push down on the secondary folding lock located just above the Release Lever on the right hand side.
- Pull up both frame release levers located just below the stroller handle, and step back while Guiding stroller downward. Continue folding until the chassis lock engages.




Swivel wheels

 To make the wheels swivel or lock, lift the tab on the front of the wheel housing.

Footrest

 Press buttons on both sides of the leg rest hinge and hold while raising or lowering the footrest to the desired position.




Reclining the seat

- To recline the seat push the buttons on both sides of the stroller seat, and position the seat at the desired angle.
- *Ensure the second seat(bottom seat) canopy is pushed back before reclining the top seat.
- There are 3 positions for the seat, fully reclined, fully upright, and a middle position.


Handle adjustment

 Press and hold the two release buttons on the outside of the handle assembly while raising or lowering the handle to the desired position.



Using the safety harness

The LUNAR Stroller is equipped with a 5-point adjustable harness system. The shoulder harness is adjustable in height and can be changed by unthreading the strap from its current position and rethreading it through the shoulder belt positioning loop at the desired height. The length of the shoulder straps can also be changed by sliding the buckle on each shoulder strap. The waist belts are adjustable on either the right or left by using the adjustment buckles on the waist strap.



▲ WARNING: Always fasten the 5-point harness securely and properly around the child's body whenever the child is seated in the stroller.

▲ WARNING: Never leave the child unattended when seated in the stroller
