
- Read all instructions before assembling and using product. Failure to follow all warnings and instructions may result in serious injury or death.
- 2. Keep Instructions for future use.
- 3. NEVER LEAVE CHILD UNATTENDED. AWAYS keep child in view when in stroller.
- Adult assembly required.
- Always ensure that all components are correctly fitted and fixed.
- Unit may become unstable if manufacturer's recommended load is exceeded, or if parcel bag or accessory other than that recommended by the manufacturer is used or hung from the unit.
- 7. Children and adults should be clear of moving parts while making stroller adjustments. Damage to fingers or extremities may occur when opening or closing the frame.
- 8.This toddler seat is suitable for children from newborn up to 49lbs/22 kg.
- Suitable from birth in bassinet mode up to a maximum weight of 20 lbs or until the child can sit up unaided, roll over or push itself up on its hands and knees.
- ALWAYS use the stroller in the fully reclined position for babies who have not yet developed good head and neck control.
- 11. The restraint system must be used at all times.
- 12. Maximum weight for the storage basket is 11 lbs/5 kg
- Maximum weight for the cup holder is 1 lb/0.5 kg.
- 14. This product is not suitable for running or skating.
- 15. DO NOT use with more than one child in the seat at a time
- 16. DO NOT carry or lift the stroller with child in it
- 17. DO NOT use the basket as a child or pet carrier
- Keep Away from fire. DO NOT use this product near an open fire or exposed flame.
- The brake must be locked while taking the child in or out of the stroller, and when parked.
- 20. DO NOT use the stroller if any part is damaged, broken, torn or missing. Use only replacement parts and accessories supplied and approved by the manufacturer.



### Assembly

### Step 1 - Frame assembly


Release the storage latch. To unfold the stroller, simultaneously lift handle and pull up with a swift motion until and audible 'click' is heard. This will ensure the locking mechanism has engaged.






# Step 2 - W heel assembly

Front Wheel Assembly-Align the shaft on the wheel with the hole in the front leg and push in. Listen for a 'click'.





Rear Wheel Assembly - push each wheel pin into the sides of the brake bar until you hear a "click". Give them a tug to ensure they are attached securely.








### Step 3 - Seat assembly

Align the seat with the frame and push downwards, listening for a 'click' to lock in place.

The footrest is in same direction as front wheels.








# Step 4- Canopy assembly

Align the two canopy plastic slides with the two seat slides and simultaneously push towards the centre as shown.



# Step 5- Attaching bumper bar

Align bumper bar shaft with the hole in the frame and push in. Listen for the 'click', then repeat on the other side.



# 1. Operating front swivel lock

To lock, push the swivel locks outwards. To unlock, push the swivel locks inwards.



# 2. Operating brakes

To apply the brake, press down firmly on the brake lever. To release the brake, press the brake lever upwards.



### 3. Adjusting the handlebar

Press the buttons on two sides of handlebar, to lift or press into three-position adjustable.



#### 4. Convert bassinet to seat

The backrest can be adjusted by tightening the adjustable belt under the sleeping basket into a sitting position, half reclining or sleeping mode to meet the different requirements of your baby.



### 5. Adjusting seat recline

Squeeze adjuster clip and pull in a upwards or downwards motion to adjust backrest position.



# 6. Adjusting canopy

To use the canopy, pull the front edge forward to open. There is a peek-a-boo window for parents to watch baby. Four-position adjustable.



# 7. Adjusting footrest

Press the buttons on two sides of footrest, to lift or press into three-position adjustable.





# 8. Put your cup

Attach the cup holder to the frame and put your cup into it.



### 9. Securing your child

Attach each of the 4 harness straps into the central buckle. To tighten or loosen the waist and/or shoulder straps, hold and lift the plastic adjuster. Adjust straps to desired position. The waist strap needs to fit firmly around the child.







# 10. Folding stroller

Remove the stroller seat by lifting the release levers on either side. Push the two buttons on the handlebar and meanwhile push down the handlebar to close the frame.




### Tips 1: Reverse seat direction

Press the seat release buttons on both sides and lift the seat .Turn the stroller seat around and align with the frame and gently push down. Listen for 'click' to lock in place.




Tips 2: Reverse bassinet direction

Press the seat release buttons on both sides and lift the seat .Turn the stroller seat around and align with the frame and gently push down. Listen for 'click' to lock in place.




# Tips 3: Fit with infant carrier

Insert the adapters into carrier joint. Align the adapters and stroller frame the push down until a "click" heard.



Lift the lever release on the back to take out the carrier. Remove the adapters.



#### Care And Maintenance

- Always store in a clean and dry place.
- Clean the frame by wiping with a damp cloth.
- · Do not use abrasives, bleach or strong detergents.
- Spot clean fabrics with warm water and mild soap.
- · Ensure fabric is dry before storing.
- Regularly check for loose parts and tighten when required.
- Damaged or broken parts should be immediately replaced.
- Do not allow children to stand on the axle/brake bar between the wheels. This is unsafe and could damage the stroller.

- 8. Please ensure that the child is always securely strapped into this product at all times. The seat belts must be properly adjusted to keep the child secured. If the seat belt is too loose the child could fall out thus causing injury. If the seat belts are too tight it will cause injury and aggravation to the child.
- 9.Never leave the child unattended or without parent\guardian supervision while in this product, as injury could be caused by other parties intentionally or unintentionally. This product can be knocked over and the child can be injured.
- 10.Never lift this product while the child is in it. This can cause this product to fold and thus causing injury to the child seated in this product.

When confronted with a staircase, no matter how many steps there are, please use the alternatives such as an elevator\lift or ramp or remove the child from this product before using the staircase.

11.Never allow the child to stand on the seat of this product. This can cause this product to fold and thus causing injury to the child. The child can also fall out of this product causing injury to him\herself. This can also cause damage to structure of this product.

12. This product is designed for the use of only one child. This product cannot accommodate more than one child.

13.Always engage the brake when you are not using this product. Please note, by applying the brake one still cannot leave the child unattended and without parent supervision. If the brake is not engaged properly the product will move.

14. Take special care when adjusting the backrest if the child is seated in this product. It is preferred to select the desired backrest position before seating the child this product.

15.Prevent and do not allow any child to climb into this product or hang onto the handle bars or any other part of this product. This imbalance of weight can cause this product to topple thus causing injury.

16.Do not hang or place any diaper bag or shopping bags or any other item over the handle bars or canopy of this product. This weight can cause damage to this product and also cause this product to fold or topple.

17. Storage trays\storage compartments\cup holders are there for convenience and are not suitable for holding large amounts of liquids (hot or cold) or heavy objects. These areas are also not waterproof or leak proof and spillage can occur.

18.The storage basket situated underneath the seat can hold a maximum weight of 5kgs. Do not place any items heavy than 5kgs and items which do not fit in this basket as this will hamper the performance of this product.

19.This product is fit to carry a child weighing no more than 22kgs.
20.This product was designed to be used on smooth surfaces and in average weather climates. Do not use this product on rough terrains and uneven surfaces and in extreme weather conditions. Using this product in the undesired terrains and weather conditions can cause serious damage to this product and to your child.

21. Chelino takes no responsibility and will not be held liable for any damage or injury caused by using this product or if this product is used for any other purposes other than its intended purpose.

22. Please note, there are no warranties or guarantee on any fabrics or sponge grip handles used on this product.


